To celebrate this important season within the Catholic liturgical calendar.

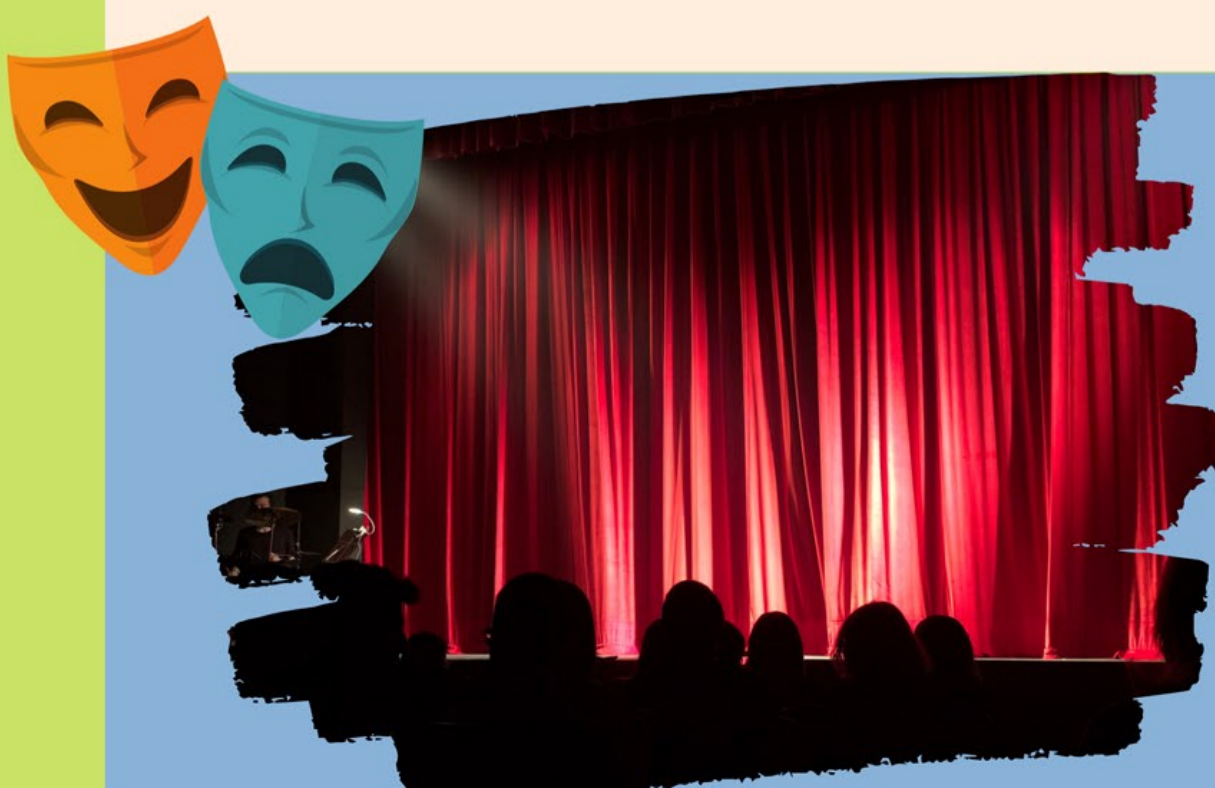

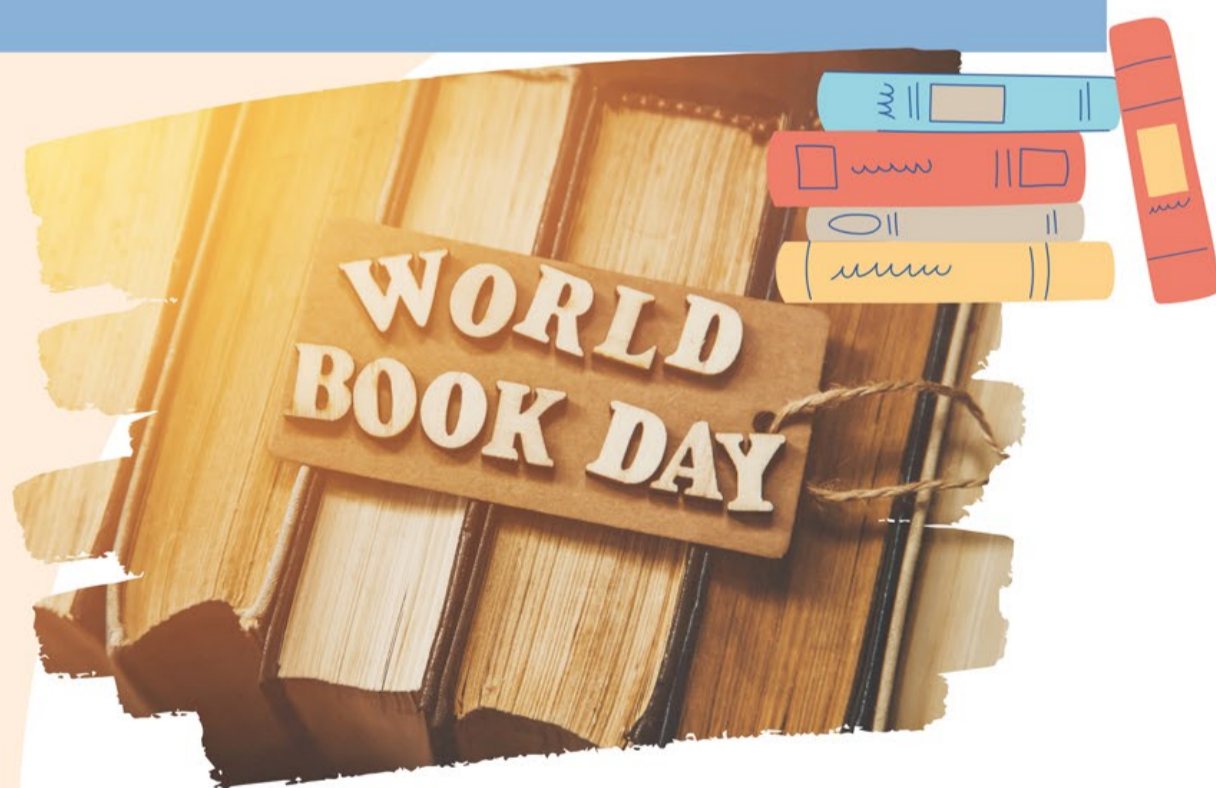

To develop a growth mind-set in order to build aspirations and goals for the future. To introduce children to the world of work.

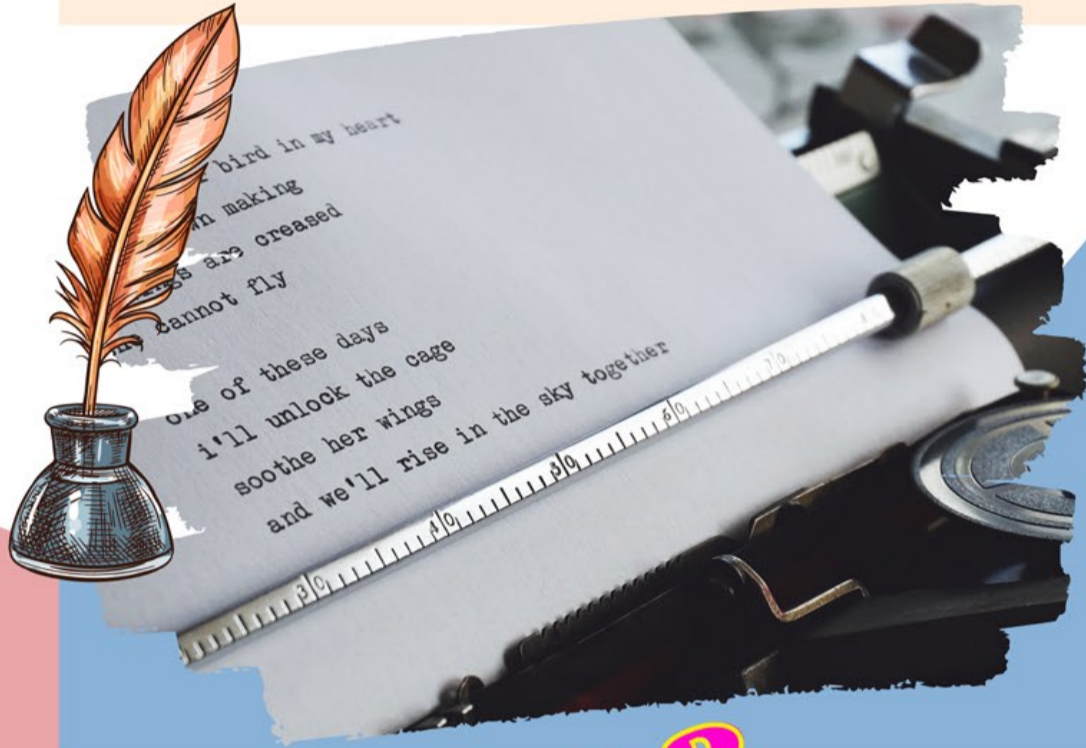
