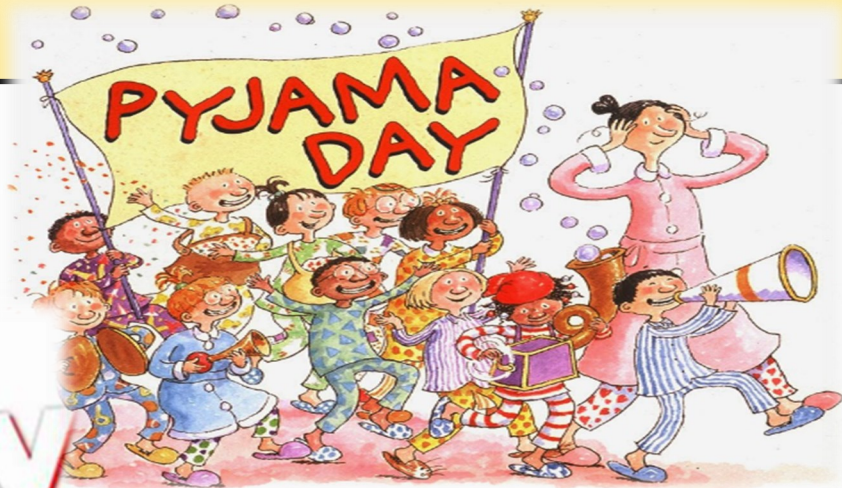
Next week we will be launching 'Anti Bullying Week' here in school. The theme for this year is: **'Make a noise about bullying'**.
