Dear Parent and Carers,

To celebrate the end of a busy year, Big Ben Class will be visiting Cotswold Farm Park on Wednesday 10<sup>th</sup> July 2024. This will be a great opportunity for the children to immerse themselves in an engaging and educational experience where learning meets fun. They will create memorable moments, foster curiosity, and inspire a deeper understanding of farming, animals, and the countryside.

The children will take part in a 45-minute talk/workshop customised to suit their age group from an expert team, covering a range of topics related to Cotswold Farm Park and farming on a broader scale. They will have the opportunity to handle and meet animals as well as feed them. They will also meet some rare breed animals and play a bingo game where they have to spot the animal. There is a woodland and play area to explore in addition to the inflatable bouncy pillows which are always a 'big hit'!

The children will leave school by bus at 8.30am, so please could they arrive for 8.15am.

They will be picked up at 2.15pm and they will return to school in time for pick up at 3:15pm.

The cost of the trip is £20.00 and a payment item has been added to ParentPay (students in receipt of pupil premium will pay a discounted rate of £10.00 for the trip). Consent for the trip will be given when payment is made.

Your child does not require to bring any money on this trip. On this day the children will come to school wearing school uniform. Please could they also bring a coat, sunhat, sun cream, packed lunch, a morning snack and a water bottle.
