

Dear Parents/Carers,

Year 2 – Trip to Southern Down – Wednesday 9th July

Fantasia Class will be visiting Southern Down beach, on Wednesday 9th July. This trip is in connection with our Geography topic, 'What is it like to live by the coast?'. During the day, the children will have the opportunity to visit the Glamorgan Coast Visitor Centre, play in rock pools, build sandcastles and enjoy the experience of being at the seaside. Children will not be swimming but they will be allowed to paddle in the water at the edge of the sea under close supervision. There are toilets available close to the beach.

We will leave school at 9.00 am and the coach should arrive back for normal school pick up time.

The children will need to wear clothes appropriate for the beach, including trainers (for climbing over rocks) and should bring a packed lunch in a rucksack, as well as a drinks bottle and morning snack. They will also need sun cream, a hat, a towel and swimming costume. If your child has a bucket and spade then this would also be a lovely thing to bring but not essential. At some point during the day they may have the opportunity to buy an ice-cream or lolly. If they would like one then please could they bring £3.00 in a named envelope or purse.

The cost of the trip is £ 14.00 (or £ 7.00 for those in receipt of pupil premium) and a payment item has been added to ParentPay.

Consent for the trip will be given when payment is made.
