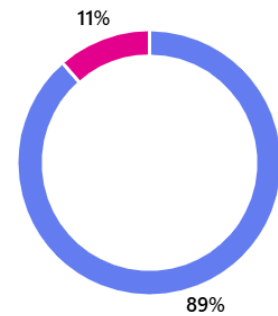

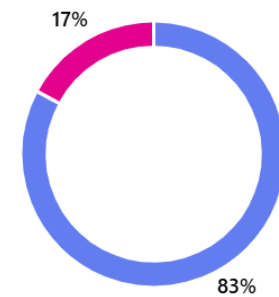
1. My child is happy at this school

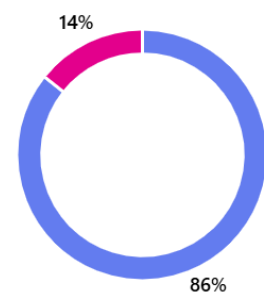
2. My child feels safe at this school

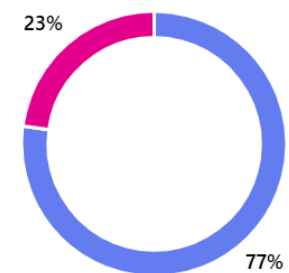
3. This school enables my child to behave respectfully

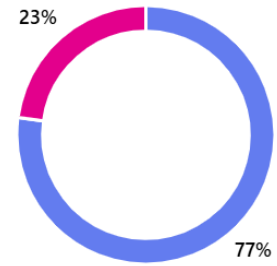
4. This school is a supportive and joyful community

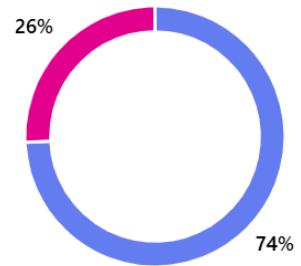
5. Staff at this school are positive role models for my child

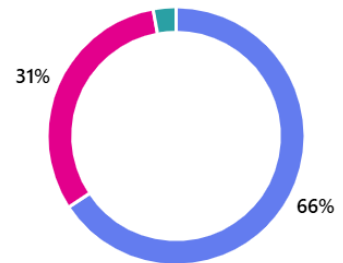
6. The school works well with the local parish

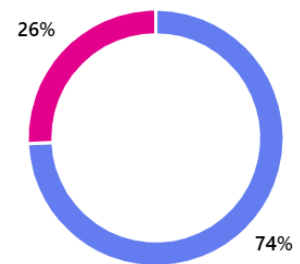
7. I understand the school's Catholic mission and I am supportive of it

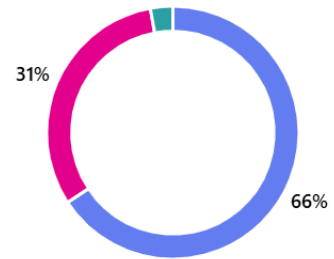
8. The school supports me in my role as the first educator of my child

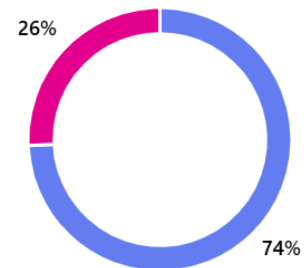
10. I know how well my child is doing in Religious Education and how to improve.

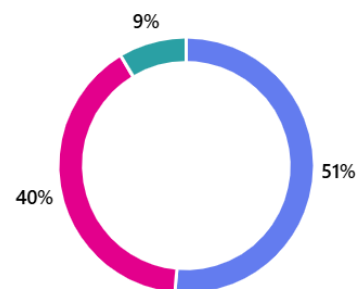
11. The school supports my child's spiritual and moral development
