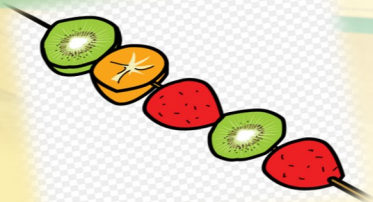
Learning in action

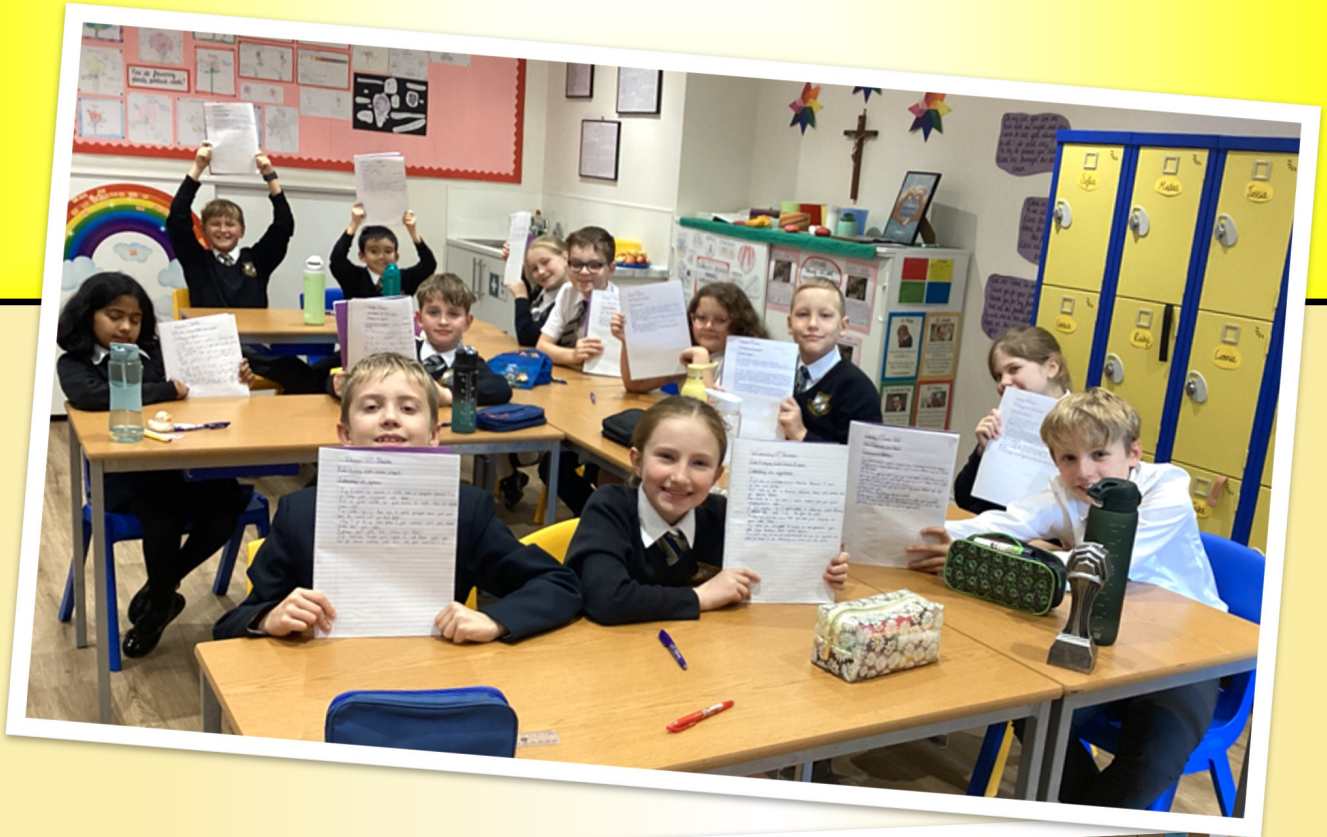
